Objectives and Investment Policy

The Company seeks to achieve capital growth over the long term (5 years).

The Company will seek to achieve its objective by investing at least 70% in equities and collective investment schemes (which may include those managed by the ACD and/or Investment Manager) which provide exposure to equities. The Company is actively managed and equity exposure is typically expected to be in excess of 75%.

The Company may also invest in convertibles, money market instruments, deposits, loan stock and other debt securities and collective investment schemes to the extent that each is permitted by the FCA Regulations.

Derivatives (that is sophisticated investment instruments linked to the rise and fall of the price of other assets) may be used for efficient portfolio management purposes including hedging (although it is expected that use of derivatives will be limited).

The Fund will not have any particular industry or economic sector focus and as such weightings in these may vary as required.

The Fund is actively managed.

You can buy and sell shares in the Fund every Tuesday and on the last working day of each month.

If you hold accumulation shares, any income from the Fund will be reinvested to grow the value of your investment.

If you hold income shares, any income from the Fund may be paid out to you.

Recommendation: This Fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

Risk and Reward Profile

The fund has been classed as 5 because its volatility has been measured as relatively high.

The following risks are material in addition to the risks captured by the indicator above:

- **Counterparty Risk:** The Fund can conclude various transactions with contractual partners. If a contractual partner becomes insolvent, it can no longer or can only partly settle unpaid debts owed to the Fund.
- **Market Risk:** External factors can cause an entire asset class to decline in value which would result in a decrease in the value of investments.
- **Currency Risk:** As the fund invests in overseas securities, movements in exchange rates may, when not hedged, cause the value of your investment to increase or decrease.

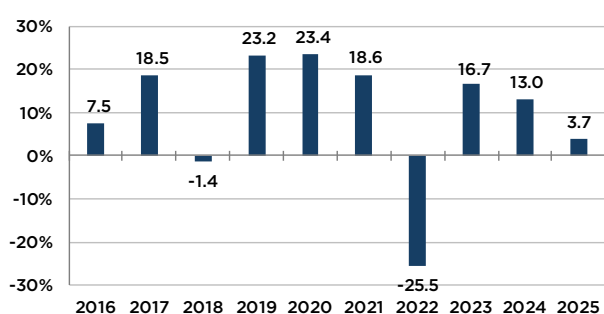
